INTRODUCTION TO WEARABLE ART WITH LINDA JACKSON

Linda, well-known artist and pioneer of the Art of Fashion in Australia in the early 70's, will be conducting "The Artist's Clothes" a colourful introduction to wearable art. Topics to be discussed will include:

- Self expression through creating your own art clothes
- Explore your Passion for colour and textile design
- Examples of print, paint and colour in cloth and costume
- Different techniques employed to capture colours and patterns
- The potential of layering a collection of prints to create artwork that can be digitally printed as Art Scarves
- Demonstrate ways of creating clothing or simple shapes to wear without a pattern.
- Group discussion and share interests and stories

Linda will share a pictorial narrative of her artform with "Essence" DVD, a collection of images from the past 4 decades, and a journey through the Australian landscape with her vintage fashion and textile archive. View her book "The Art of Fashion" and also Jenny Kee's book "A Big Life".
